### Information Sheet for Students

#### SKILL

• To complete this challenge, you'll have to think of a skill that you'd like to develop, or improve upon. The main emphasis in this challenge area is on your commitment to see it through and how much you improve from start to finish. You could consider one of the following, or a skill of your choice:

Horses - handling & care Music (instrument)
Newsletter & Magazine production Digital Photography
Public Speaking & Debating Singing (School Choir)

#### COMMUNITY

• In this challenge, you'll select one community activity for participation. For example:

Caring for the disadvantaged Environmental conservation
Helping young people Helping the elderly
First aid Riding for the Disabled

#### **PHYSICAL**

• In this challenge, you'll select a sporting activity to learn or to improve upon. For example:

Track & Field athletics Team Sports
Swimming Martial Arts
Rock Climbing Sailing

#### **EXPEDITION / ADVENTURE**

- For this challenge you will plan to go on an expedition of some kind.
- For the Silver Award you will be out for three days & two nights & cover approx 25-35km.
- Required will be Walking Boots, Sleeping Bag, Rucksack, & Waterproof Clothing (to be properly equipped for the expedition it may take upwards of £100 so think carefully)! Some equipment you may be able to borrow from friends or family.
- Insect repellent (Skin so Soft [Avon], Expedition Plus etc).
- Training will take place 1 afternoon per week after school & on some Saturdays everyone is required to attend all sessions!
