

Remote/Distance Learning

Guidelines for Students and Parents/Guardians

Introduction

Subject teachers will work together to ensure continuity of education for students throughout the period of disruption brought about as a result of students having to self-isolate. These guidelines outline the expectations of temporary remote learning for students.

Use of Digital Platforms to Support Learning

Staff will use Google Classroom as the main digital platform to share work with students. However, some subject teachers may wish to communicate with students using other digital means, eg C2k email.

Students should ensure that they have access to Google Classroom on the digital devices they intend to use at home (using their C2k login details, e.g. student123@c2ken.net). Students requiring technical advice should contact Mr Keith Elgin (School Network Manager) via the school email (info@ loretocollege.org.uk) as soon as the issue arises.

Any student who does not have access to devices or the internet at home should let their Form Teacher know so that appropriate support arrangements can be made, including the loan of IT equipment (where available) and provision of paper based resources.

Engagement with Learning

The expectation is that students will fully engage with their learning (health permitting).

- Students should keep their routine as close as possible to a normal school day by following their normal timetable on the days they are working remotely this will ensure that they spend the right amount of time on each subject studied, while at the same time managing their time and workload.
- Students should regularly monitor, e.g. on a daily basis, the digital platforms by which each subject teacher delivers material to check for information and any feedback provided.
- It is the student's responsibility to follow all instructions given by their subject teachers and to attempt to complete all assigned tasks. Subject teachers, Form Teachers and/or Year Heads may contact students and/or their parents/guardians in the event of students not engaging with their learning.
- Subject teachers will inform students if they are to submit work, and how they should do this.
- Subject teachers may use a variety of methods to give students feedback on their work.

Student Guidance for Effective Remote Studying

- 1) Continue your daily routines as if you are going to school, from your breakfast to shower and dressing routines, including a 9:00am start this will help you engage more fully in the learning experiences.
- 2) Where possible, try to create an appropriate space for studying, one that is quiet and free from distractions (including the use of your mobile phone!).
- 3) Do your best to be independent and proactive in your learning. Make sure you understand the tasks assigned to you by your subject teachers and any deadlines set by them. Do your best to organize your studies and to meet timelines, commitments, and hand-in dates. Communicate proactively with your teachers if you cannot meet deadlines or require additional support.
- 4) Be aware that school rules and policies on behaviour etc. extend to remote learning, including expectations for online etiquette.

HOME-SCHOOL COMMUNICATION






